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The WCM Work-Study Program (WS)

- Funding for eligible students through <u>federal</u> or <u>institutional</u> funds & sponsor funds. Supports research or clinical projects.
- □ Funds are earned as temp. employment via WCM \$4,000 stipend
- Available for medical students in the summer after 1st year <u>only</u> (MD Class 2022)
- □ All interested must <u>first</u> complete a FAFSA for 2019-20 to determine federal eligibility. If not eligible -> institutional funds can be used
- □ First-come basis (limited funding) & intended as last option for research funding. We encourage you to seek more generous funding (external)
- Are you an international student or not federally eligible? Institutional funding may be provided (Barr fund is still limited- first come basis)
- WS requires a 50% contribution from your research sponsor (PI) -No exceptions! You must ask your sponsor about their funding for summer!

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Work-Study Eligible Programs

Find a project and PI you would like to work with.

• Your PI <u>must</u> agree to participate in the program and provide a **50%** contribution to your earnings (\$2,000 from PI). Work-study will pick up the remaining \$2,000; you are guaranteed a max \$4,000 total.

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Application Requirements

- 1. Application form available online on FA website as of now deadline May 1st. https://studentservices.weill.cornell.edu/financial-aid/forms-resources/2-md-work-study
- 1. You must indicate your start & end employment dates date must fall within the 10 week period you are allowed to work (Jun 10th to Aug 18th)
- Discuss terms with your PI and ensure s/he is willing to participate by contributing 50% to your earnings – This is a valid agreement between Student – PI – Fin Aid Office
- 3. Your PI will be invoiced at the end of the summer, and must repay the Fin Aid Office per the signed agreement (\$2,000)
- 4. Once you are approved by FAO, you must comply with the Human Resources on-boarding** requirements before your start date. You must submit:
 - a. Temp Employee Hire forms
 - b. Tax Forms
 - c. Proof of employment eligibility
 - d. An appointment will be required Materials & more info will be provided

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Compensation Overview

- Maximum earnings during summer = \$4,000. You may complete your project within the 8-10 week summer period. Hours are up to your discretion (you decide with your PI).
- 2. Time-sheets will be required We still have to collect a record No exceptions! Flexible, but, rule of thumb: 35 hrs. max per week w/lunch.
 - a. No holiday pay (do not log this i.e. you don't log work on 7/4th)
 - b. No overtime pay (do not log more than 7 hrs. per day)
- 3. No work before or after designated dates (Jun 10th to Aug 18th). Please stick to the 8-10 weeks of the summer period.
- 4. Payroll tax deductions will apply. Ask HR if you have tax form related questions.
- 5. Paychecks distributed every 2 weeks direct deposit option available
- 6. If you are awarded other funding, please withdraw your WS application to allow room for others to apply.
